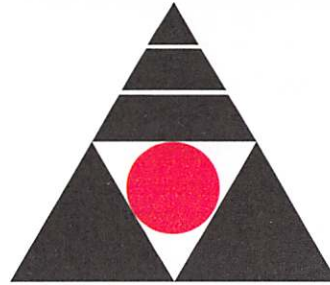

- ▲ Other publications are produced on an ongoing basis.

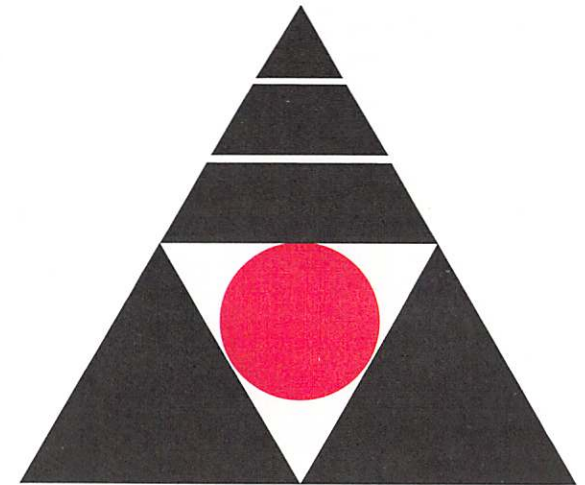
