The 2005 OAME/Union Gas Ontario Mathematics Olympics (OMO) will be held this year in Sudbury on Saturday, June 4<sup>th</sup>. We expect that teams will arrive by 3:30 pm on Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. Registration will take place at *University College Residence* on the Laurentian University Campus.

The event will be held at Laurentian University (935 Ramsey Lake Road P3E 2C6) and at Science North. Students will have the opportunity to see an IMAX film and experience the 4-D thrill of *Wings over the North*. 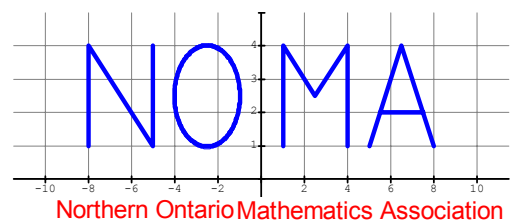

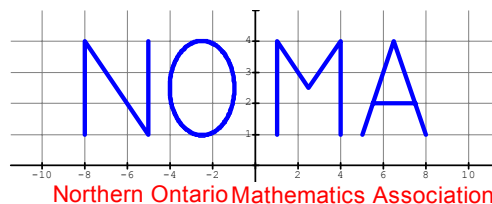

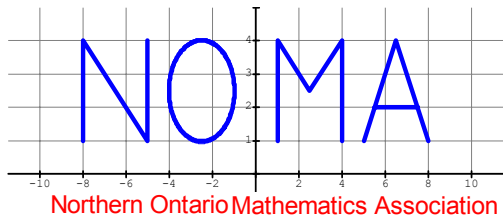
